CURRENT POLICIES

PROPOSITION 3: UTAH DECIDES HEALTH CARE ACT

Utahns voted to expand Medicaid to 138% FPL; which will provide health insurance to 150,000 Utahns earning less than \$34,638 per year for a family of four.

TENTATIVE START DATE:

APRIL 1, 2019

MEDICAID FAMILY PLANNING WAIVER

House Bill 12 (Family Planning Amendments) calls for Medicaid to provide family planning services for individuals with incomes below 100% FPL who are ineligible for full Medicaid. Stay tuned for start date.

Effective Jan. 1, 2019: immediate postpartum LARC contraceptive implants and copper IUDs placed in the delivery room or prior to discharge will be covered by Medicaid. Hormonal IUDs may also be covered with pre-authorization.
